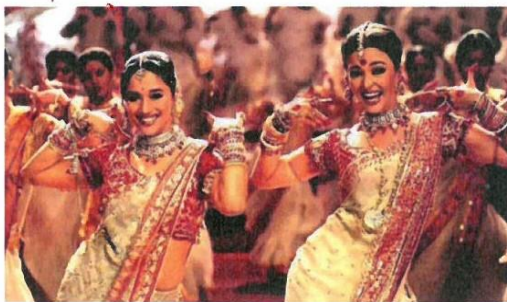

Year 4 & 5 – ‘Bollywood’ dance performance – Monday 25th March



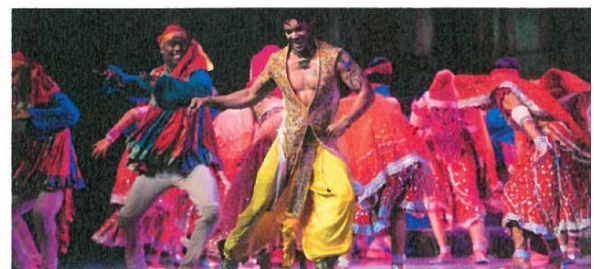
