Dear Parents/Carers,

I have some very exciting news about our autumn trip to launch our topic. On **Thursday 27th September 2018**. We are going to visit Stonehenge to see for ourselves the majesty, awe and wonder of it, and ponder how it was built. During the day we will be exploring the whole Stonehenge site, and enjoying a range of activities at the Visitor and Education Centre.

All school trips are self funded by parents/carers. The cost of this trip is £12.30 per child which includes the day at Stonehenge and coach travel costs. The payment will be set up to enable you to pay via ParentPay, alternatively if you wish to pay at a paypoint, then please speak to the office who will provide you with a barcoded letter. If you have any difficulty with any of this, then please come and speak to me.

The whole trip will occur within normal school hours, therefore your child should be brought to school at 8:50am, ready for the coach departing at 9:30am and we return to school by 3:15pm, so your child can be collected at the end of the day at 3:30pm. Due to the outdoor nature of the site and the seating arrangements (the floor!), I ask that the children come in robust trousers worn with their school uniform shirts, cardigans or jumpers. Please ensure that the children have a sun hat and sun cream if the weather is fine, and a waterproof coat whatever the forecast is. Sufficient footwear will be trainers, however if the weather has been particularly wet leading upto the trip, welly boots may be more suitable.

As we will be out of school all day the children will need to have a packed lunch with at least one drink (no fizzy drinks or glass bottles). Please complete the attached form to indicate whether you will provide your child with their own lunch or whether you would like school to provide a lunch for them. You will need to indicate what you would like your child to have in their school prepared lunch if you select this option.

We are really looking forward to our day at Stonehenge and I am sure it will be educational as well as fun-packed! Please ensure you complete, sign and return the attached forms by Monday 24th September 2018.
