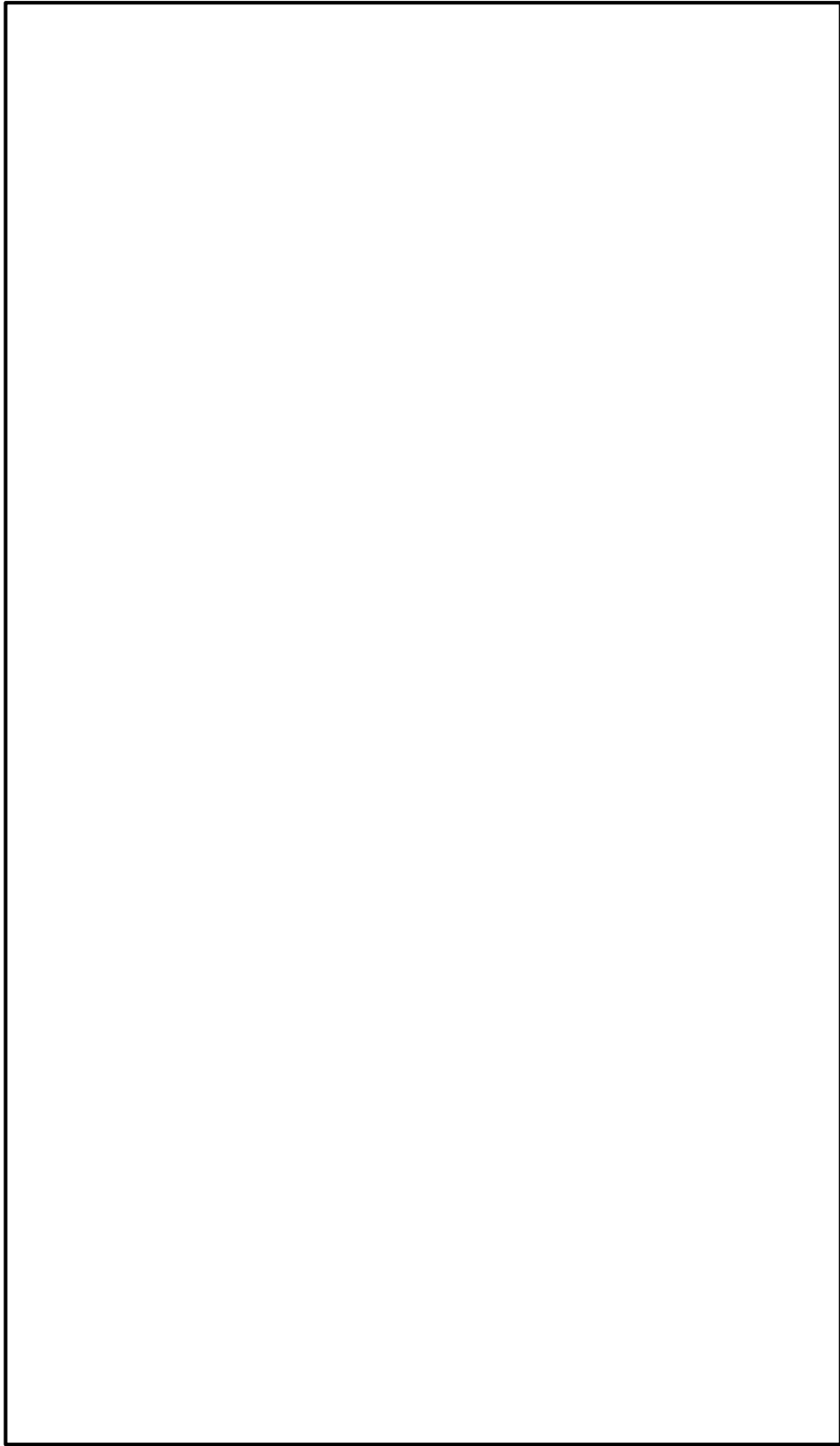

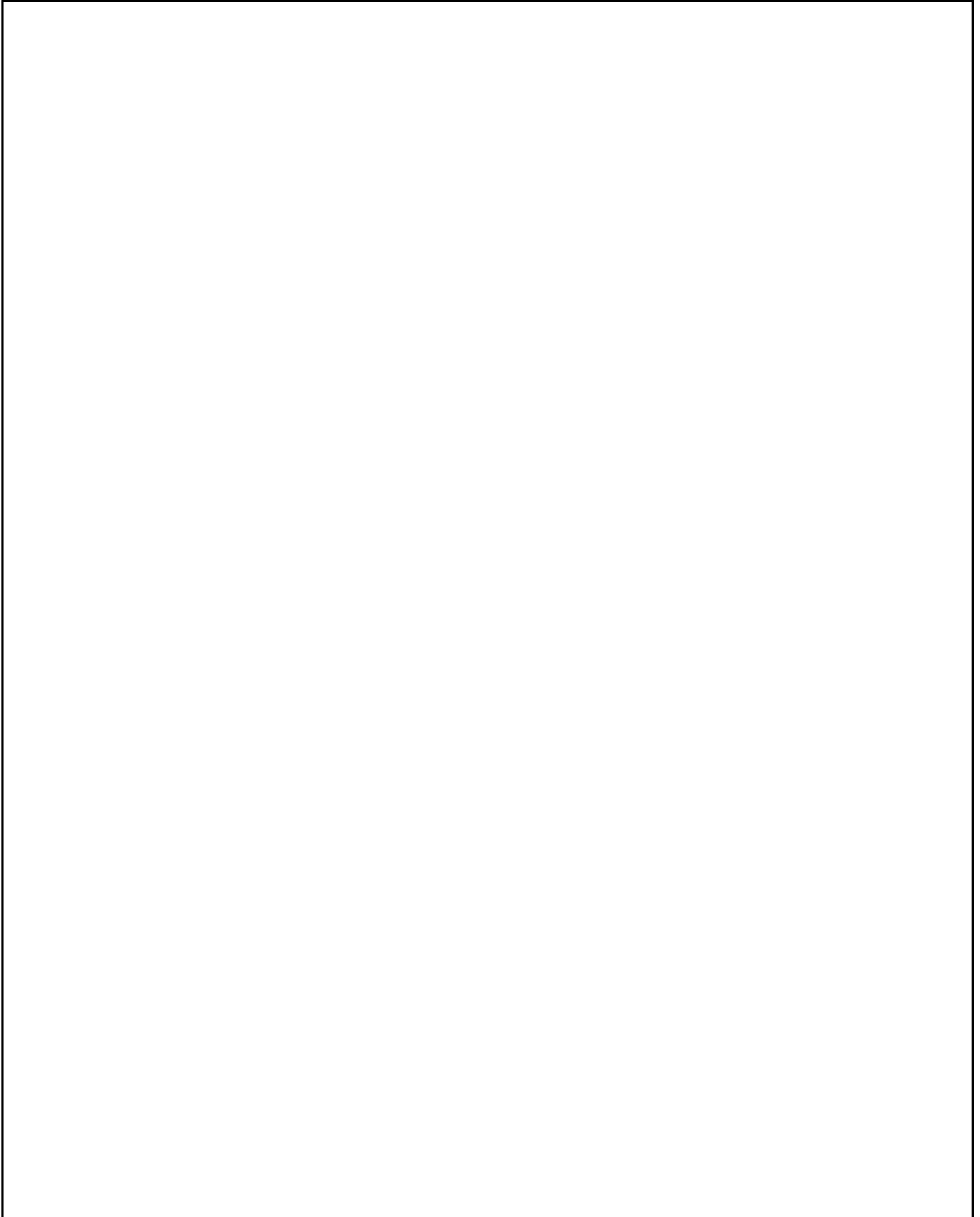
Information
