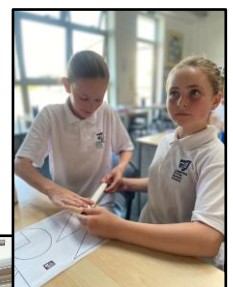
Our newest families joined us for their first taste of life in Merlin on Thursday afternoon. The Stay and Play sessions hosted by Miss Morris and her wonderful team were very

Following the recognition of our Gold award for Careers Education, we were delighted to host a week of visitors across classes to share in their job experiences, roles and highlights.



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First up were the Royal Navy, who put Lancelot through their paces, constructing communication towers and streamlined rockets. Mr Gilmour led Excalibur and King Arthur through his fascinating role of a waterproofing surveyor – creating compounds to demonstrate the science behind his day-to-day tasks!



On Tuesday, Mr Slade brought in fire extinguishers to help explain his role of fire security technician to Merlin and Pendragon classes – I'm sure there were plenty feeling that they would have loved to be sprayed by the cold water at that point!



Meanwhile, King Arthur and Lancelot welcomed two representatives from BAE systems, who discussed their company's important defence contracts and explained the journey of designing jet fighters and their differing individual roles within the company.



The hottest day of the year couldn't stop Mrs Clifford and Mr Clay from joining Excalibur and Lancelot on Thursday morning to share with classes their roles of a lawyer and a robotics engineer

respectively. Children were inspired by both with plenty of chat afterwards about which they would prefer to be!



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Thursday also saw Mr Wilson visit Lancelot, sharing his role as a Thames barge captain – with a family history in the business spanning over 500 years! King Arthur and Excalibur were joined by Ms Cotter, who discussed her role as a barrister with lots of debate following her visit around how important it is not only to be able to explain yourself, but also present facts clearly and calmly under pressure!

Excalibur class enjoyed a virtual visit from author, Lee Newbery. Organised in conjunction with Waterstones to learn about his new series, *Holomonsters* – the interactive session explored imagination, gaming, AI, teamwork and self-belief, and

included a live card battle and a Q&A with the author!



Rounding out our week,

Mrs Tagg explored the differences between a barrister and solicitor with Lancelot, as well as the intriguing perspective of a being a CEO of a large firm in London. In Pendragon and King Arthur, Immi Maxwell shared her experience of
