Sutton Bingham Reservoir Trip: Tuesday 4th March 2025

What your child needs to bring: bag, lunchbox, water bottle, trainers and wellington boots.

Lancelot class have been learning about Natural Resources in Geography this term with a focus on water. In March, we are visiting Sutton Bingham Water Treatment Works to find out more about how water is recycled and how it is treated before it reaches our taps and how water companies play their part in the water cycle.

Please can all children bring in a warm coat as well as a reading book. Children should wear their school uniform but with the exception of shoes which should be as follows: it is advised that children wear trainers for the first part of the day in which the children will be having a guided tour of the water treatment centre.
