This report details the work of Countess Gytha PTFA for the period of March 2020-March 2021.

I'm sure most of you are aware that this has been the first year of the current PTFA as the school has been without a PTA for several years. This has been quite a challenging first year as Chair for me and taking on the role has been both daunting but enjoyable in equal measures!

I am very grateful for the encouragement & support this past year provided by Mr Talmage & previously by Mrs Thompson and also all the teachers & school staff that have assisted with events, fundraising and ideas throughout the year. The committee and I look forward to forming a strong partnership with the new headteacher Mr Gordon too.

Our aim this year has been to get our newly established committee up and running and to build up a fund with which we could then plan events & purchase stock and equipment. We have worked on promoting good relations between staff and parents and supporting the wellbeing of pupils with events that were hopefully enjoyable & accessible to all the children and their families.

The primary function of the PTFA is to fundraise, which Heidi will cover in the Treasurer's report. We have been cautious with spending this year whilst trying to build up funds but have managed to donate a new supply of dictionaries, provide the children with a virtual pantomime & ice-cream at Christmas and also helped out towards the cost of the forthcoming science dome visit. We will continue to fundraise towards the outdoor learning allotment area and for the purchase of a large polytunnel this year.

Events undertaken have included- Mufti days, competitions, a virtual balloon race and Christmas fair, several Bag2school collections and the recent sponsored readathon. We hope that a relaxation

in COVID restrictions will mean that we can plan more school-based events, particularly those that involve the local community. The committee have lots of ideas for fundraising but we are always open to suggestions!

Finally, a word of appreciation to everyone involved in the PTFA this past year, you have given your time and energy to get us established in what has been an incredibly difficult year for everyone, your efforts ensure that the PTFA continues to build and strengthen and I think we can be really proud of what we have achieved together. - Treasurers Report for Countess Gytha PTFA

Financial Year 1st September 2019 to 30th August 2020

Under the fantastic leadership of Nicki Rowlands, Countess Gytha PTFA has had a very promising start. Overall fundraising events generated a profit of £233.25. This may seem small but with only this being donations and no actual events held the money was generated from 2nd hand uniform sales, the 5p challenge and bags 2 school collection.

The total income generated from fundraising activities was £246.70 with expenditure of £13.45. The attached report shows a breakdown of these figures by individual event (in date order).

The school lent us the money for the membership to Parentkind annual subscription of £115 to allow us to build some funds. This money has since been repaid.

Countess Gytha PTFA ends the financial year with a bank balance of £233.25

As a quick guide to how we are progressing this year we have currently raised income of £2167.35 and have had outgoings of £1334.27. Giving us a profit of £833.08.

This is great as we have had to purchase most things from new including storage and now, we are more established hopefully we can start providing some fantastic enrichment for the children.

Hopefully with the children returning to school now we will be able to push forward with fundraising ideas that we have not been able to perform that will give more interaction with the children in the coming months.
