they will be joined by Miss Emily Young — a trainee teacher — learning her craft from the brilliant Miss Morris and her team for the remainder of the autumn term.






Parents' evening meetings are due to take place next week



The deadline for September 2025 secondary and upper school place applications is 31 October. The online Citizen Portal will close at midnight!! If you do not apply by 31st October, you are at risk of missing out on a place at your preferred school and your local school.

Most school open evenings have taken place now so please go online and make your application if you haven't already done so.

You can make changes right up until the deadline but don't forget to resubmit your application each time.

A few tips before you start;

- 1. If you previously applied for a child starting or transferring school in 2017 or earlier you will need to re-register on the portal as a new system was introduced at this time.
- 2. If you do not receive your registration or forgotten password email please check your junk mail. If you still do not received an email please contact schooladmissions@somerset.gov.uk
- 3. We do not use Unique Identification Numbers (UID) in Somerset so if prompted, just click 'NO UID'. As with any IT system there is always the potential for unforeseen issues so if you experience any problems, please let us know and we'll look into it as quickly as we can.
