Week 1

Monday - Story Map




Once you have finished your pictures add key words or expanded noun phrases to your story map. Make sure you remember a capital letter for names of places and characters.


Tuesday – Write the beginning and middle of the story

Now it is time to write the beginning and the middle of the story. Remember to use your story maps from yesterday to help you. I have added some pretty paper for you to use if you want to.

Make sure that you write in full sentences. Using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops. It is also a good idea to read your work out loud as you go along, to check it makes sense. Don't forget to add in lots of lovely adjectives to make it interesting. I have also attached a sheet to help you with different sentence openers, I don't want to see lots of 'and then' in your stories.

Practise the words on this list using look, say, cover, write and check.


