When thinking of words to describe your animal you may want to use your five senses to help you:












Monday – Charlie the Chimpanzee is caught






Can you write about what Charlie the Chimpanzee does when he sees the zookeepers? Is he a good monkey and does he go straight back to the zoo or does he have other plans?






