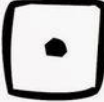


Draw like Picasso – Art for Pack 1

Picasso was a distinctive artist who looked at the world differently! He often broke pictures down into bits (like smashing things to pieces) and then put them back together in a different order. His work belongs to a style of art known as cubism. I've no doubt you would recognise his work instantly.

As a warm up to the main project – draw yourself a basic face shape and then use a dice to decide on what features you give it – use the table below to copy some of Picasso's designs!
