



This week's art project concerns one of the most famous pictures in the world – The Scream! This is one of many versions by Edvard Munch who is a famous 19th and 20th Century painter (most famous for capturing the emotion of fear!). This version is in pastels but there is also a (more famous) painted version.

You'll notice that the whole image is actually created using an outline (pencil) and then simple straight and curved lines in pastels (no form of shading or smudging and no real 'colouring in'. The effect is great so task 1 is to try and recreate this image using similar techniques! Copying the original outline could

be done by eye (break the page into four quarters or even into eighths to help get each section correct, or through tracing).
