Aim

Staff at Countess Gytha Preschool are deployed to meet the care and learning needs of children and ensure their safety and well-being. There are effective systems in place to ensure that adults looking after children are suitable to do so.

Objectives

- Recruitment checks meet the requirements of the EYFS.
- All staff and volunteers who work more than occasionally with the children have enhanced DBS
 disclosure checks. All staff and volunteers working with children have appropriate training, skills and
 knowledge.
- All staff, students and volunteers know how to complain and who they complain to.
- There is a whistleblowing procedure for all staff, students and volunteers to raise any concerns they may have.
- Parents/carers are involved in their child's learning, and their views are considered.
